
Growth story of the Logistic industry

Eligibility Criteria

Graduation (industry experience will be preferred) in any discipline from a recognised university with a minimum of 50 per cent marks.

Selection Process

SIES SBS follows a holistic selection process. All candidates who meet the eligibility criteria will be invited for Personal Interview. The final merit list will be prepared based on the overall score of the PI, academics (10th, 12th, graduation), and extracurricular achievements.
