Ganpati festival was celebrated with great enthusiasm at Deepsikha, Assam Bhawan, prayers were offered for well being good health and prosperity for ALL.



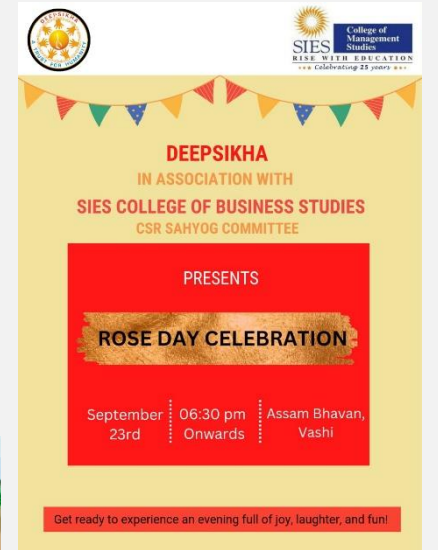
SIES Management students visited Deepsikha, Assam Bhawan as a part of the college CSR Sahyog Committee.
