Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for PGDM / PGDM (Pharma and Biotech) Admission Batch 2025-27

1. What is the minimum educational qualification required to get into the PG program?

Ans: Graduation (minimum three-year duration) in any discipline from a recognized university with minimum of 50 per cent marks. The students who are appearing for final year examination / awaiting final year results can also apply (Candidate will need to submit graduation results by May 31, 2025). However, for Pharma & Biotech program, one needs to be Pharma Graduate or graduate in any science discipline with 50 per cent marks.

2. What are the various entrance exams considered for admission into PG Programs?

Ans: We consider marks in any of the following All-India examinations: CAT 2024/ CMAT 2025/ / MAH -CET 2025/ GMAT/ XAT 2025 / ATMA-Dec 2024, Feb 2025

3. If I have not appeared for any of the entrance examinations till date, but planning to appear will I be considered for admissions?

Ans: Yes, you can apply and provide the details of the once the results are declared by the testing body and timeline announced by the Institute. Final admission is based on the Merit list drawn from the Holistic Selection.

4. What is the minimum cut off scores in each of the tests that are considered?

Ans: SIES SBS follows a Holistic Selection Process. Hence, there is no prescribed minimum cut off score for any entrance test. All students meeting the Eligibility criteria will be invited for the Group Discussion and Personal Interview. Final admissions will be based on Merit list drawn on the basis of the Holistic Selection Process as mentioned in the Selection Criteria.

5. What scores do I submit if I have given all the exams?

Ans: You can submit all scores of whichever exams you have appeared for. We will give you the benefit of the best of scores provided.

6. Can I apply now and update my scores later?

Ans: Yes, you can apply now and re-login to update the entrance exam score once the entrance test result is declared. You need to pay only once for the application form.



7. What are the selection criteria for PGDM programs?

Ans: SIESSBS believes in the 'Holistic Selection Process' while selecting students considering their past academic records, extra-curricular activities, work experience, if any, marks obtained in all India qualifying exams and the selection process of the institution. However, due weightage is given to all the given parameters as per the AICTE guidelines.

The final selection of the candidates to the program will depend on the total score:

Parameters of Holistic Selection Process	Weightage
Qualifying Entrance Exam (viz CAT/XAT/CMAT/MH-CET/ATMA)	35%
Academic Performance (10th,12th and Graduation)	15%
Group Discussion and Personal Interview	40%
Extracurricular Activities	10%
Total Score for Merit List	100%

Personal Interviews will be based on-

- a. **Technical Interview**: These interviews test your basic knowledge basis information provided in your Application Form and look into your overall understanding of the business environment.
- b. **Competency based In Interview**: Competency or behavioural interviews are based on the assumption that past behaviour is the best predictor of future behaviour. The interviewer will want specific examples of when and how you demonstrated behaviours.

The Merit Listing will be based on weighted average of the above parameters.

8. Where would the admission process be conducted?

Ans: The Admission Process will be conducted **OFFLINE** (ie Face to Face Group Discussions and Personal Interviews) at various centres in the following cities:

Navi Mumbai Campus, New Delhi, Bengaluru, Kolkata, Ahmedabad, Indore, Nagpur, Jaipur, Lucknow

10. How is the placement scenario at SIESSBS?

Ans: SIES SBS is an extremely ROI friendly Institute that provides excellent Value for Money.

11. What are the different specializations offered by SIESSBS?

Ans: The institute offers <u>four</u> specializations in PGDM program: Marketing, Finance, HR & Operations PGDM Pharma & Biotech have the major specialization in areas of Marketing and Operations The Institute also offers Analytics related courses across all these specialisations.

12. What is the intake of students in different PG programs?

Ans: Post Graduate Diploma in Management (PGDM): 120

PGDM (Pharmaceutical Management) -: 60

PGDM (Biotechnology) -: 30

All the above programs are AICTE approved.



13. What type of reservations the institute has?

Ans: SIES is a Tamil Linguistic Minority Institute. Hence 51 per cent seats of all programs are reserved for Maharashtra domiciled students with 'Tamil' as the mother tongue.

However, if adequate number of qualified candidates is not available from the above category, such seats are made open to other linguistic minority & general candidates. (Further, all admissions to SIESSBS are based purely on merit. The only exception is children of employees of SIES institutions.

14. What is the application form fee for each program?

Ans: a) For AICTE all PGDM programs, the Application Form Fee is Rs. 2100/-. Candidates may apply for one or all programs for the same fee.

15. How is the application fee to be paid?

Ans: The application form fees are to be paid Online using the Payment Gateway provided online.

16. What is the fee structure for various PGDM programs?

Ans: The fee structure for the year 2025-27 is as follows (Fees are payable Annually):

PGDM - Rs 5,00,000 per year

PGDM-Pharmaceutical Management-Rs 4,00,000 per year

PGDM Biotechnology- Rs 4,00,000 per year

Note: for students who would like to go in for Global Immersion Program have to pay additional approx. Sum of Rs 1.50 lacs approximately to cover the cost of international trip.

17. Are there any management seats?

Ans: No, all seats are purely on merit except children of employees of SIES institutions. The institute does not charge any **Capitation Fees**, whatsoever. Further, the institute does **NOT** have any admission agents for the purpose of admission to any of the programs at SIESSBS.

18. Will I get refund of fees if I cancel my admission?

Ans: Refund Policy will be as per AICTE rules.

19. Does SIESSBS offer any loans / financial assistance through banks?

Ans: The institute has details of some bank and assistance is provided for getting bank loans. However, usual terms & conditions of the banks would apply.
