The peer reviewed process would be in a strict, double-blind way to guarantee the quality, integrity and academic relevance of research published in the proceedings. Appropriate manuscripts are anonymized and forwarded to two or more independent expert reviewers after a preliminary editorial review of scope, originality, and compliance with ethical standards. The reviewers use criteria like methodological rigor, theoretical contribution, clarity, and relevance in evaluating the paper. According to the reports of reviewers, the editor decides, whether to accept or to reject or to revise it, with minor or major revision. Revised manuscripts can be reviewed once again before being accepted finally. This open-minded and objective procedure maintains the standards of good scholarship and contributes to the spread of reliable research.
